

Primary School Admission Requirements (Grade 1 – Grade 6)

Primary School Grade 1

The most important requirement for enrollment in the first year of primary school is that the student demonstrates School Readiness Skills. It requires the mutual agreement of the teacher, school counsellor, the school administration, and the family. Both the family and the school should agree on a “proper fit”, taking into account the child's needs and the curriculum and objectives of the program. The guidance counselor interviews the candidate student and manages the necessary preparatory tests. The candidate student should demonstrate the following skills at an optimum level:

- Intellectual Skills
- Socio-emotional Skills
- Scholastic Skills
- Fine motor Skills
- Verbal Skills

Primary School Grade 2 – Grade 6

From Grade 2 to Grade 6, all candidate students interview with the principals, the guidance counselor and the IPYC coordinator. If the student's English language level is behind the class, the school provides special studies and/or differentiated activities to improve the student's English language skills. Nord Anglia Nantong asks the student a formal letter about the student’s social, emotional and cognitive development which is written by the guidance counselor or the principal of the previous school.

Middle School Admission Requirements (Grade 7 – Grade 9)

From Grade 7 to Grade 9, all candidate students interview with the principals, the guidance counselor, the IMYC coordinator and the Head of English Department.

The school asks the student to document his / her grades in the previous school. In addition, a formal letter about the student's social, emotional and cognitive development should be brought from the guidance counselor of the previous school.

Middle School – Grade 9

Students who wish to register for Grade 9 are obliged to conduct the above-mentioned interviews and bring the required documents.

In addition, students are expected to have **at least 70% GPA** in Chinese, English, Mathematics and Science courses in their previous school. If the GPA of a student is below 70%, the parent is interviewed, but the school reserves the right not to accept the student.

High School Admission Requirements (Grade 10 – Grade 12)

From Grade 10 to Grade 12, all candidate students interview with the principals, the guidance counselor, and the Head of English Department. The school asks the student to document his / her grades in the previous school. In addition, a formal letter about the student's social, emotional and cognitive development should be brought from the guidance counselor of the previous school.

Nord Anglia School Nantong applies Chinese, English, Maths and Science exams to students who want to enroll in high school. Students must be successful in these exams and in order to register in high school. Besides, students' Zhongkao score must be 75% for the enrollment to the high school.

High School – Grade 10

Students can register to the 10th grade by November at the latest.

High School – Grade 12
